



GRPC OUTRIGGER CANOE REMINDERS & GENERAL INFORMATION

Welcome to the Fall/Winter Outrigger Season!
Below is important information ... for some paddlers new information and
to others a review and reminders.

BOAT ALLOCATION

All crews are assigned a maximum of 6 boats for one week-day session and one week-end session. Any OC6's required over and above the maximum must be requested in advance with the BoatHouse Office. An additional fee will be charged for more than 6 boats.

BOATS & EQUIPMENT

We have been working to consistently maintain equipment including all of the canoes, paddles and PFD's, to ensure they are in safe working condition.

- If there is an equipment issue or a repair required please report this to a staff member immediately.
- We now have fresh water to the north dock ... please ensure you use it to rinse all boats.
- Canoes, iakos and amas for all outriggers are to be left properly secured, clean and hosed down following each use. This includes OC6's, OC1 & 2's.
- Paddles & PFD's are for on premise use only and are not to be taken off the property.

BOAT SIGN-OUT/SIGN-IN

It is mandatory that ALL boats must be signed out with boat type, route and crew. When you return ensure your crew is signed back in.

BOAT RESERVATION

You are able to reserve a small boat (OC1 or OC2) for yourself using our individual reservations procedure:

- Book up to 1 week in advance.
- Provide your name and contact phone number.
- Reservation may be done in person or by phoning the BoatHouse directly ... 250-380-4668
- There will be a 10 minute leeway for your arrival on the day of your reservation. If you fail to arrive and have not called to say you are on your way the boat will go to the next paddler in line.

GUESTS

Anyone not registered in a program and not paid in full is a considered a guest. All guests must ...

- Sign a waiver once per season
- Pay \$5.00 per paddle, payable at the kiosk in the BoatHouse.
- Be accompanied by a registered member.
- Maximum of two visits during a one month period.

SAFETY

- The "Safety Board" is located beside the Office with Tide Chart, Extreme Weather Policy, etc. It is there for your knowledge ... please use it.
